- Implementing, monitoring, and reviewing SHE objectives that guide our performance.
- Promoting proactive management of SHE practices, empowering employees, and encouraging their active participation in SHE matters.
- Encouraging employee consultation and participation in SHE programs including hazard reporting, environmental stewardship, safety committees, and decision-making processes.
- Planning, implementing, reviewing, and improving SHE performance through audits, inspections, and risk assessments
- Embedding environmental management practices in operations, including pollution prevention, waste minimization, spill prevention, and responsible resource utilization.
- Ensuring the provision and maintenance of PPEs and work equipment, enforce permits for high-risk tasks, and promptly investigate incidents and implement corrective actions.
- Continual improvement of the Occupational Health & Safety Management System (OHSMS)

We recognize that responsibilities for Safety, Health & Environment are shared:

- Management is accountable for leadership, provision of resources, continual improvement of the SHE program, and ensuring a safe and environmentally responsible workplace.
- All employees are responsible for fostering the right safety and environmental attitudes, complying with SHE requirements, reporting hazards, and ensuring that all operations are conducted with full regard for their own safety, the safety of others, and the protection of the environment.
